Additional credits include Young Little Edie, *Grey Gardens* (Broadway World Nomination Best Featured Actress Musical) opposite Broadway veteran Sara Gettelfinger, SoCal premier *Jerry Springer: the Opera* as Shawntel/Eve (Broadway World Nomination Best Featured Actress Musical, Susan in *Nerve* (Best Performance Lead Actress in a Play OC Registrar), Madame Thénardier in *Les Misérables*, Pam Sakarian in *Baby*, Yum-Yum in *The Mikado*, and Irene Malloy in *Hello, Dolly!*



David Laffey / MAN - David has appearing in productions throughout Southern California including *Camelot*, *The Mikado* (Nanki-Poo), *The Secret Garden* (Neville Craven) and *Crazy for You* (Moose). In 2011, David earned an Ovation nomination for Best Actor in a Musical for his work in the Southern California premiere of *Jerry Springer: The Opera*. In 2013 David was part of a concert staging of *West Side Story* with the San Francisco Symphony. That production's cast album won the International Classical Music Award for Recording of the Year and was nominated for a Grammy.
